

Case 2

Mark is 2 years old and tested positive for cocaine. It is unknown how Mark got cocaine in his system. The mother (26) and child live with the paternal grandmother (57). On 08/05/13, Mark was playing at home outside and collapsed. He also suffered a seizure. Mark was taken to the hospital. On 08/06/13, Mark was given a urine test. On 08/10/13, Mark's urine test came back positive for Cocaine. It is unknown how Mark got cocaine in his system. The mother and grandmother denied using drugs.

The grandmother's friend was visiting the grandmother when the child fell. According to the report, the child has been exposed to the following people and places on the day he collapsed: the mother, the grandmother, the grandmother's friend and the daycare.

Mark attends daycare and it is unknown if staff members are using drugs at the facility. The mother reported giving Mark Singular, Zytrec and Albuterol the same day for allergies and asthma. Medical staff reported that these medications do not contain any form of cocaine in them. No further details are known. The incident occurred on 8/5/2013 but DCF was not notified until 8/22/2013. The father's whereabouts are currently unknown.

The father has an extensive criminal history. The mother and grandmother have no criminal histories. There are no prior abuse reports regarding Mark. There are prior abuse reports regarding the mother who is listed as a victim from the time she was a child.

On 8/16/13, an abuse report was received alleging that the mother stated that she was raped twice by the father of the children who is her paramour's brother. Her paramour is incarcerated and expressed that he does not want a relationship with her due to the relationship with his brother. The mother locked herself in the bathroom and attempted suicide while the children were in the home. The mother called relatives and 911 while she was committing suicide in an effort to have the children supervised.

On, 10/2/13 CPI added an allegation of Family violence to the abuse report because the mother and MGF had a physical altercation and he punched the mother.

There are 6 prior abuse reports regarding the mother of the children as a victim as follows:

2012-12345 MGF (alleged perp) Physical Injury

FINDINGS: Not Substantiated Allegations of Physical Injury found in the investigation. The child was seen with scratched on his nose which was attributed to a fall. Case staffed with CPT who determined the explanation was plausible. The mother was referred to Healthy Start.

2010-12345 MGF (alleged perp) Sexual Abuse

FINDINGS: No Indicators found of the allegations in the investigation. The reporter admitted to making false allegations, the VC did not disclose the abuse and collaterals expressed no concerns for the children. LE did not accept the investigation. Services were declined by the family.

2010-01234 MGF (alleged perp) Inadequate Supervision/ Substance Misuse

FINDINGS: No Indicators found of the allegations in the investigation. The father denied abusing substances and declined to submit to a test. The child turned 18 years old during the investigation. Collaterals stated the father drinks alcohol but does not seem intoxicated or to be a threat to the child.

2004-12345 MGF (alleged perp) Inadequate Supervision

FINDINGS: No Indicators found of the allegations in the investigation. The child was not found to be at risk in the home of the mother's boyfriend. Referral for Daycare and individual counseling for the father were submitted.

2000-12345 MGF (alleged perp) Family Violence Threatens Child/Alcohol Exposed Child

FINDINGS: Some Indicators of Family Violence Threatens Child and No Indicators of Alcohol Exposed Child found in the investigation. The parents engaged in an altercation. The father committed a self-inflicted injury and was arrested by LE. The mother left the home with the children and declined services.

1999-12345 MGF (alleged perp) Excessive Corporal Punishment

FINDINGS: Verified allegations of Excessive Corporal Punishment found in the investigation. The father was found to have discipline the minor with a belt. The child sustained injuries on the head due to the discipline. The mother and child moved out of the home. The mother was referred to parenting skills classes.
