Questions/Response Options:

1. What is the danger (safety) threat?
 - A. Substance abuse
 - B. Environmental conditions are hazardous
 - C. Domestic violence

2. How are the children vulnerable?
 - A. Children are only 3 years and 1 year old
 - B. Child's communication and cognitive processing skills are limited
 - C. Child's understanding of cause and effect is limited
 - D. Children express fear of one or more caregivers
 - E. All (A, B, C, D)
 - F. A, B, and C only

3. What is known about protective capacities?
 - A. There are not any protective capacities identified
 - B. Mother appears to recognize danger of DV incidents to her children
 - C. Father has a job

4. What safety decision is most congruent with available case information and in alignment with danger threats, child vulnerability and protective capacities, plus diligent efforts and least restrictive setting?
 - A. Child is safe
 - B. Conditionally Safe: child will stay with mom and a visitation plan will be established to reduce parent interactions
 - C. Child needs to be placed in out-of-home care

5. What safety actions are needed, if any?
 - A. New visitation plan
 - B. Personal Protection plan implementation for Mom
 - C. No safety plan is needed
 - D. A and B only
